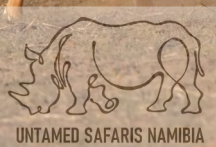
Intu Africa Zebra Lodge

The Kalahari Desert is a vast semi-arid region characterised by unique geological features, diverse ecosystems, significant climatic variations, and rich cultural history, making it one of Southern Africa's most intriguing landscapes.

The Zebra Kalahari Lodge is located approximately 250 km from Windhoek. The journey to the lodge will take us through the stunning landscapes of the Kalahari Desert, where wildlife often rests under trees or near water pans. It is one of three luxurious lodges within the Intu Afrika Private Game Reserve. This lodge is renowned for its stylish and elegant accommodations. It is the perfect place for the first night in Namibia to unwind and enjoy immersive nature experiences. Activities include game drives in open-air 4x4 vehicles or quad biking adventures across the dunes. Take guided walks with the Bushmen (San people) or soothing massages.

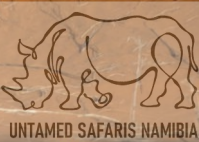
Sossusvlei Lodge

Etosha National Park is in northwestern Namibia, approximately 300 km from Twyfelfontein. It is one of Africa's largest national parks, covering an area of approximately 22,270 square kilometres. The park features diverse geographical elements, including saline desert, savanna woodlands, and grasslands. The Etosha Pan itself is a significant geological feature that can attract various bird species during the rainy season. Etosha National Park is home to a rich variety of wildlife, including approximately 114 mammal species, over 340 bird species, and numerous reptiles. Notable species include elephants, lions, black and white rhinoceroses, zebras, springboks, and various birds such as flamingos and vultures. The park plays a crucial role in the conservation of endangered species like the black rhinoceros.

The Taleni Etosha Village combines luxury with nature, offering comfortable accommodations and a variety of activities that allow guests to fully engage with Namibia's unique environment.

The Okonjima Nature Reserve sprawls over 200 square kilometres of undulating plains, mountainous outcrops, and riverine thickets, and it is here that leopards (*Panthera pardus*), the most adaptable of all the wild cats, thrive. The Okonjima Nature Reserve, a huge, protected area set amongst the rugged commercial farmlands of central Namibia, comprises a diversified ecosystem representative of both the larger and smaller mammals of Namibia, as well as most of the country's endemic birds.

Game drives and guided bush walks offer visitors an intimate, up-close perspective of Namibia's wildlife and, especially, its most protected species.

The Okonjima Nature Reserve is home to and runs extensive research projects on rare and endangered species, big and small.
